SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 61256, dated December 28, 1960, made various revisions in connection with the rates for the transportation of certain grocery items, canned goods and related articles. Among other things, this decision found that macaroni and cheese, in combined packages, should be included with other items in the group designated "Groceries and Grocers' Supplies" in Item No. 360 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

By this petition, filed March 20, 1961, Kraft Foods
Division of National Dairy Products Corporation seeks the addition of spaghetti and noodles with dry or powdered sauce mix to the list of groceries in the tariff item.

Petitioner alleges that the items sought to be added are similar to macaroni and cheese in combined packages in that they all consist of a dry dough product with a package of cheese, cheese sauce or dry sauce mix included in the same carton. It asserts that all of the products here involved have similar transportation characteristics; that they are manufactured at the same facilities; that the proposed adjustment will make possible the application of one billing description to variations of these products; that these items are shipped in mixed shipments and that one description will simplify

billing and rating of shipments of these commodities.

On or about March 17, 1961, petitioner mailed a copy of the instant petition to the California Trucking Associations, Inc. That association, by letter dated March 23, 1961, advised the Commission that it has no objection to the granting of the proposal.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that petitioner's proposal is reasonable. This is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The petition will be granted.

Inherent in the petition is relief from the long- and short-haul provisions of Article XII, Section 21, of the Constitution of the State of California, and Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code, in order to permit the application of the sought rating to rates which are nonintermediate in application. For the reasons that departures from the above statutory provisions were authorized for the rates, like authority is justified for application of the exception rating. Such authority will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 1, 1961, the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:

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2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be filed not earlier than the effective date hereof, and may be made effective on not loss than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the exception rating authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Article XII, Section 21, of the Constitution of the State of California, and Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code, to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the exception rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
