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ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The applicant is now authorized to haul livestock as a highway common carrier under a certificate issued by Decision No. 44523, in Application No. 30945. This authority was first issued to Garibaldi Bros. Trucking Co., a co-partnership, and was transferred to Garibaldi Bros. Trucking Co., a corporation, under Decision No. 49601, in Application No. 35031, dated January 26, 1954, and subsequently transferred to applicant Garibaldi Equipment Co., Inc., pursuant to Decision No. 52124 in Application No. 37205, dated October 25, 1955. The current authority is contained in Decision No. 52558 in Application No. 36169 dated January 31, 1956.

The applicant also operates under Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 19-23475; Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 19-23476 and City Carrier Permit No. 19-38883.

By this application, filed March 10, 1961, the applicant has requested that the Commission issue its order suspending all permits and certificates held by the applicant for a period of 180 days. The allegation is made that the livestock hauling business is presently unsettled due to (1) a drought in the western states, (2) the import of dressed beef into California, and (3) the recent heavy use of proprietary trucks by livestock owners.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that a suspension of the operative rights of the applicant is necessary and will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by Garibaldi Equipment Co., Inc., a corporation, by Decision No. 52558 dated January 31, 1956, in Application No. 36169, is hereby suspended for a period of 180 days from the date of this order.

2. That within thirty days after the effective date hereof, and on one day's notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs showing the suspension of service authorized in paragraph 1 hereof.

3. That the following permits issued to and held by the Garibaldi Equipment Co., Inc., are hereby suspended for a period of 180 days from the date of this order:

- a. Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 19-23475.
- b. Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 19-23476.
- c. City Carrier Permit No. 19-38883.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
