SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding the Commission issued its Order Instituting Investigation, dated September 13, 1960, and, by Decision No. 61737 dated March 28, 1961, determined that Lyle V. Abbott, doing business as Ace City Delivery, possesses no warehouse operative rights.

Ordering Paragraph 3 to the above decision canceled Warehouse Tariff No. 2, Cal.P.U.C. No. 2, whereas it should have canceled Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, for warehouse location at Maywood, and Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, for warehouse location at Vernon, California.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the following Ordering Paragraph 3 be, and it is, substituted in place and stead of Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 61737 dated March 28, 1961, in this proceeding:

"3. Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, for warehouse location at Maywood, and Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, for warehouse location at Vernon, of Lyle V. Abbott, doing business as Ace City Delivery, are hereby canceled."


In all other respects, ~~Decision No. 61737~~ Decision No. 61737 shall remain in full force and effect.


