ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE OF INVESTIGATION

By Decision No. 61397, issued January 24, 1961, herein, it was ordered that submission herein be set aside and that the matter be held in abeyance pending the filing of further reports by the respondent pursuant to paragraph No. 6 of Decision No. 57504, or request for dismissal or further hearing by the Commission staff counsel.

Counsel for the Commission staff has now filed a written request for dismissal by memorandum dated April 18, 1961. This request was based on a staff memorandum dated April 6, 1961, advising that the only remaining uncollected undercharges of respondent are those due from Hawkins Mill, and a staff memorandum dated March 28, 1961, advising that Hawkins Mill is out of business, there are large tax liens against the mill which are uncollectible, three of the five partners who owned the mill are deceased, and the remaining two are unemployed and do not have sufficient assets to justify the filing of bankruptcy proceeding.

IT IS ORDERED that the memorandum of the staff counsel and copies of the other memoranda referred to herein be made a part of the formal file in this proceeding and that the investigation herein is discontinued.
