ORDER

City of La Mesa is authorized to construct Alvarado Avenue at grade across a spur track of San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company in the City of La Mesa, San Diego County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No.

36D-13.7-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
