BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to abandon its Class "B" non-agency station at Warner, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California, to retire 309 foot spur track (formerly used as team track), to cancel all tariffs to and from said station, to delete said station from the timetables, and to correct records accordingly.

<u>O R D E R</u>

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company filed on May 5, 1961, discloses that the amount of freight business transacted at applicant's station of Warner, San Bernardino County, during the past two years no longer warrants its continued maintenance.

It being found that public convenience and necessity no longer requires the maintenance of such service, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Warner, County of San Bernardino; to remove a spur track at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not
