ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

THET WOO WONG, of 716 East 9th Place, Los Angeles, California, having filed a verified complaint, Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, of Los Angeles, California, having filed a verified answer, and complainant having filed a verified petition for interim relief, and said complaint and petition together alleging in substance that complainant applied for telephone service to be furnished by defendant at complainant's address on or about April 1, 1961; that defendant refused and continues to refuse to furnish telephone service; that defendant justifies its refusal to furnish telephone facilities to complainant upon probable cause for its belief that said telephone facilities will be used for unlawful purposes; that complainant has no police record; that complainant has suffered and will continue to suffer irreparable injury and undue hardship if deprived of said telephone facilities; and complainant having requested an order directing the defendant to furnish said telephone facilities and service

pending a hearing and determination of the matters raised by the complaint and answer; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY is hereby directed to furnish telephone facilities and service to complainant and to maintain such service pending further Commission order herein, said service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be set for hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the amended complaint herein, to be served upon Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company.
2. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant.
3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
