O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade along and across a portion of California Street, a traveled unimproved dirt road, at Ivy Street, in the City of San Diego, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-266.71-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, with superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

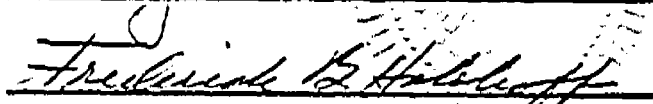
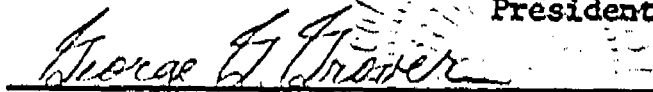
Applicant declares that due to considerable delay in obtaining necessary permits from the City of San Diego, the industry to be served is severely restricted by lack of rail service at its dock for loading and unloading. It therefore requests waiver of the usual twenty-day waiting period.

The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
