SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Farmers Public Warehouse & Hi & Dry Warehouse, Inc., a corporation, operates as a public utility warehouseman in the vicinity of Marysville and Sutter. On March 22, 1961, it filed its amended articles of incorporation changing its corporate name to Hi and Dry Warehouse, Inc. Accordingly, its operative rights will be amended to show the new corporate name. It will also be ordered to amend its tariffs by filing an appropriate adoption notice. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Appendix A to Case No. 6843 dated August 16, 1960, is hereby amended by substituting "Hi and Dry Warehouse, Inc.", in place and stead of "Farmers Public Warehouse & Hi & Dry Warehouse, Inc."

(2) That within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations governing the public utility warehouse operations here involved to show that Farmers Public Warehouse & Hi & Dry

Warehouse, Inc., has withdrawn or canceled and Hi and Dry Warehouse, Inc., has adopted or established as its own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
