SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

United Delivery System, Inc., a corporation, operates as a highway common carrier between points in the Los Angeles Basin Area, on the one hand, and San Diego Territory and San Francisco Territory and certain intermediate points on the other hand. On May 2, 1961, it filed its amended articles of incorporation changing its corporate name to United Expressways, Inc. Accordingly, its certificates will be amended to show the new corporate name. It will also be ordered to amend its tariffs by filing an appropriate adoption notice. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That Decision No. 61616, dated March 7, 1961, in Application No. 42912, is hereby smended by substituting "United Expressways, Inc.," in place and stead of "United Delivery System, Inc."
- (2) That within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations here involved to show that United Delivery System, Inc., has withdrawn or canceled and United Expressways, Inc., has adopted or established as its own,

said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
