O P I N I O N

Applicant commenced this proceeding on May 3, 1961. Public hearing was held thereon at Bakersfield on May 26, 1961, before Examiner John Power and the matter was submitted.

Applicant has authority to operate 107,840 square feet of public utility warehouse space in Bakersfield. The operation was conducted in several small buildings. At least five or six of these had been rented for manufacturing operations at the time of hearing.

Applicant had notified its last storers of the hearing. The Secretary of the Commission called the attention of the Bakersfield Chamber of Commerce thereto by letter. There were no protests to the proposed abandonment.

The Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require the public utility warehouse services of the applicant.

ORDER

Public hearing having been held and the Commission basing its decision upon the findings set forth in the foregoing opinion,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. International Fertilizer & Feed Co., a corporation, is hereby authorized to discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman at Bakersfield, and the operative rights as determined in Case No. 6715, dated August 1, 1960, are revoked and canceled, subject to the following condition:

That International Fertilizer & Feed Co. shall, within thirty days after the effective date of this order, file with the Commission its written acceptance of this order, and, effective concurrently with the discontinuance of its public utility warehouse operations and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, shall file a cancellation supplement to its warehouse tariff, Cal. P.U.C. No. 1, on file with this Commission.

2. Power of Attorney W. E. 1 No. 1 issued by International Fertilizer & Feed Co., in favor of Jack L. Dawson, Agent, effective May 9, 1950, is hereby canceled.

3. The authority granted in paragraph 1 hereof shall expire unless exercised within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
