ORDER OF DISMISSAL

It now appearing that the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transit Authority has replaced the rail passenger service with motor coaches and all movement of rail cars on this track has been discontinued, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that the application for an extension of

time to complete construction authorized by Decision No. 58782 dated July 21, 1959, in Application No. 41220, is hereby dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
