O R D E R

The City of Long Beach is authorized to construct or have constructed a spur track at grade across certain city streets and under the existing Ocean Boulevard Bridge structure in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the locations described and in the manner as shown in the application, and Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to operate thereover. Crossings shall be identified as follows:

Third Street	6LDA-1.66-C
Ocean Boulevard Bridge Off-Ramp	6LDA-1.80-C
Ocean Boulevard	6LDA-1.87-AC
Seaside Boulevard (at Pico Avenue)	6LDA-1.99-C
Seaside Boulevard (east of Mitchell Avenue)	6LDA-2.00-C

Clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense. Maintenance costs between lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by Pacific Electric Railway Company and outside such lines by applicant.

The foregoing authority is subject to the installation of protection as prescribed in Appendix "A" attached hereto and made a part of this order.

Construction of all grade crossings, pursuant to this order, shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of widths and grades of approach as shown on the aforementioned appendix attached to this order.

Prior to, or upon completion of the crossings herein authorized, Crossings Nos. 6LDA-1.81-A and 6LDA-1.92-C shall be abolished by physical closing by applicant.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
