Application of the State of California,
 Department of Public Works, for an
 order authorizing reconstruction of two
 crossings at separated grades and removal
 of two existing crossings at separated
 grades between the tracks of the Southern
 Pacific Company and State Route 37, in
 connection with the improvement of State
 Highway III-Pla, Nev-37-E,A, sometimes
 referred to as "Emigrant Gap Overhead"
 and "Yuba Pass Overhead Separation".

O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to construct State Route 37 (U.S. 40) at separated grades over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, substantially as set forth in the application, at Emigrant Gap (Placer County) and near Crystal Lake (Nevada County), respectively, being the two locations as shown in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-172.0-A and Crossing No. A-176.1-A, respectively. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Upon completion of Crossing No. A-172.0-A, the existing grade separation at Crossing No. A-172.1-B shall be abolished by physical closing and removal. Upon completion of Crossing No. A-176.1-A, the existing grade separation at Crossing No. A-176.2-A shall be abolished by physical closing and removal.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
