ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

James P. Maugh, doing business as Stucki and Jim's Truck Repair Service, recently acquired a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the transportation of property between the City of Los Angeles and Wilmington and San Pedro. The radial highway common carrier permit of this carrier was suspended as of June 27, 1961, for failure to pay quarterly fees required by Section 5003 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California for the first quarter of 1961.

The required fees not being paid and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of the certificate and of tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by James P. Maugh, doing business as Stucki and Jim's Truck Repair Service, by Decision No. 61593, dated February 28, 1961, in Application No. 43051, is hereby suspended pending further order.

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



Section 5007 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California provides in part: "If any transportation agency referred to in this chapter is in default in the payment of the fees prescribed, other than filing fees, for a period of 30 days or more, the commission may suspend or revoke any certificate of public convenience and necessity, permit, or license of such agency ..."

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of James P. Maugh, doing business as Stucki and Jim's Truck Repair Service, are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon James P. Maugh or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service or after such mailing, as the case may be, unless before such effective date James P. Maugh shall have paid the fees prescribed in Section 5003 of the Public Utilities Code, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
