O P I N I O N

Decision No. 57962 contained an order abolishing by physical closing three named street crossings under the mainline tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City and County of San Francisco. It was stipulated at the hearing that said order could properly include provisions as to easements of utility companies and of the City and County of San Francisco.

The present petition constitutes a further stipulation between the parties concerned that the requested modification be ordered. The effect is to permit the City and County of San Francisco to install new water mains and structures in the area which constituted said former crossings. The Commission finds that such modification is in the public interest. The Petition for Modification will therefore be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Request therefor having been filed and based upon the above findings,

IT IS ORDERED that the order of Decision No. 57962 is hereby amended so that it provides as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that the street crossings under the Southern Pacific Company mainline tracks in the City and County of San Francisco known as Rankin Street, Galvez Avenue, and Innes Avenue, including a portion of Hudson Avenue, be abolished by physical closing, reserving, however, to Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company the right to repair, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew those pipes, conduits, wires, poles and other structures, equipment and fixtures for the distribution and transmission of electric energy or communication currently located in, upon and over Galvez Avenue and Innes Avenue, and reserving to the City and County of San Francisco the right to repair, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sewers, pipes, conduits and other sewer structures currently located in, upon or under Galvez Avenue, Innes Avenue, or Rankin Street, together with the right to locate and operate additional sewer lines or facilities, and to install, operate, renew, relocate, repair, replace and maintain water pipes, conduits and other water structures in each of said streets.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
