City of Salinas is authorized to construct Airport Boulevard (on new alignment) at grade across an industrial drill track of Southern Pacific Company in Salinas, Monterey County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. E-120.7-C Width of crossing shall be 32 feet, the roadway to be initially located in the northerly portion of the street right of way.

Within 3 years from the date hereof, applicant shall:


- Widen the pavement at Crossing No. E-120.7-C from 32 feet to 64 feet in width.
- (2) Abolish Crossing No. E-120.6-C, located about 600 feet westerly, by physical closing.

Applicant shall bear entire construction, alteration and abolishment expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Grades of approach shall be not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be
