AMENDATORY ORDER

The Commission, following hearings and analysis of completed questionnaires returned by respondents in the aboveentitled investigation, issued Decision No. 62156 on June 20, 1961, declaring 42 of said respondents to be radiotelephone utilities.

Upon determining that its name was not included among the respondents listed as radiotelephone utilities in said decision, Salinas Valley Radio Dispatch Company on July 6, 1961, addressed

a letter to the Commission enclosing a signed duplicate copy of the completed questionnaire pertaining to its operations and stating that the original copy thereof had been timely mailed to the Commission.

Since the Commission did not receive the original copy of the completed questionnaire, it appears that said original was lost in the mails or otherwise misdirected. Upon consideration of the information contained in the duplicate copy, the Commission finds that Salinas Valley Radio Dispatch Company is a radiotelephone utility and that its name should be added to Appendix A of Decision No. 62156; therefore,
