ORDER VACATING DECISION NO. 62231 AND
REINSTATING DECISION NO. 61791

The Commission having been advised by A. J. Bumb that he is the receiver in the bankruptcy of Handy Motor Lines, Inc., a highway common carrier; that said carrier's highway common carrier certificate was suspended on April 4, 1961, and on June 30, 1961, revoked by order made effective 30 days after service thereof; that said suspension and revocation were a result of the carrier's failure to have evidence of liability insurance on file; that prior to said suspension and revocation an involuntary petition in bankruptcy has been filed against said carrier; that the suspended certificate has substantial value and that the proceeds of the sale thereof would enable payments to be made on tax claims and labor claims, and good cause appearing, now therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 62231 is hereby rescinded and the order issued therein vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 61791 and the order issued therein are reinstated.
