ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Oak Creek Road, in the town of Mojave, Kern County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-380.2.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

The above crossing protection shall be augmented by special white flashing light units used by the railroad to indicate to the enginemen that gates are down. Said light units shall be installed and connected to include the additional spur track, and engines or trains approaching the crossing shall not enter said crossing until the gates are in a horizontal position.

Applicant shall further install or arrange to have installed two 10,000 lumen mercury vapor lights so located as to illuminate sides of cars which occupy crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
