BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of Pacific Electric Railway Company for authority to construct, operate and maintain a spur track across Eucla Avenue, in the City of San Dimas.

Application No. 43610

ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Eucla Avenue, in the City of San Dimas, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6T-26.30-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the industry to be served has completed and is occupying its industrial plant and is presently receiving materials by rail. The absence of the proposed spur track facilities necessitates cumbersome and expensive handling. It therefore requests waiver of the twenty-day waiting period.
