Shasta and Panther Meadows, in Application No. 43585 Siskiyou County. <u>o p i n i o n</u> Western Greyhound Lines, an operating division of applicant, operates between a large number of California cities and the City of Mt. Shasta. Henry L. Rubidoux operates between Mt. Shasta City and Panther Meadows, a ski resort in the immediate vicinity of Mt. Shasta. Applicant has been offering Special Operations service through to Panther Meadows by a joint tariff arrangement with Rubidoux. At Rubidoux's own request, his operating authority was suspended as of March 16, 1961 (Application No. 38271, Decision No. 61673). Greyhound filed the instant application for authority to serve between Mt. Shasta City and Panther Meadows in Special Operations service. Since Greyhound already has authority along U. S. Highway 99 through Mt. Shasta City, it will be able to continue the service previously rendered under the joint rate. It appears, and the Commission finds, that public convenience and necessity require that the authority requested in the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary. ORDER Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises, IT IS ORDERED that: A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to The Greyhound Corporation, authorizing the -1establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between the points and over the route set forth in Original Page 2-A of Appendix A attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of, consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and particularly to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

- 2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating therein Original Page 2-A.
- 3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
 - (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
 - (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective, tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
