ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS


Decision No. 62313, dated July 18, 1961, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of James P. Maugh, doing business as Stucki and Jim's Truck Repair Service, unless prior to the effective date of that decision he shall have paid to the Commission the fees prescribed in Section 5003 of the Public Utilities Code, in which event the order would be stayed until further order of the Commission. James P. Maugh paid the required fees on July 21, 1961, staying the Commission's order. Inasmuch as the required fees have been paid, Decision No. 62313, supra, will be vacated and set aside.


Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 62313, dated July 18, 1961, in Application No. 43051, is hereby vacated and set aside.
