
ORDER OF DISMISSAL


Decision No. 60326 ordered Dyke Water Company, its officers, agents, and employees to desist serving water in a specified tract, physically disconnect its system from that installed in the tract, and refrain from reconnection or permitting reconnection. Thereafter, upon the filing of affidavits, the corporation, its President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, and an employee of the corporation, were ordered to show cause why they should not be punished for contempt for failure to comply with said decision.


Hearing was had on the order to show cause. It appears from the affidavit of the owner of the tract in question that service to the tract was discontinued, and that such owner has been informed by officers of the utility that they are unable to resume


service because the utility must comply with the order of the Commission. Although such discontinuance was not made within the time contemplated by the order, and belated compliance is not to be condoned, under all of the circumstances IT IS ORDERED that the contempt proceeding arising out of Case No. 6525 is hereby dismissed.
