## ORDER

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Cherter Street at grade across Union Pacific Railroad Company's San Pedro Branch in the vicinity of Vernon, Los Angeles County, as described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 3A-3.6.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Union Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 60 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,
necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
