O R D E R

City of San Jose is authorized to alter and widen Taylor Street at separated grades under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, in San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location and substantially as shown in the application, being identified as Crossing No. E-45.9-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement dated November 2, 1960, copy of which is attached to Amended Application No. 41035, filed November 23, 1960, being a proceeding related to nearby Crossings Nos. E-45.7 (Emory Street) and E-45.65 (Stockton Avenue), San Jose.

Clearances at reconstructed Crossing No. E-45.9-B shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-D.

The above grade separation project has been established as Priority No. 15 by Decision No. 61272, in Case No. 6898, pursuant to Statutes 1957, Chapter 2091, as amended by Chapter 1763 of Statutes 1959.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless

time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
