AMENDATORY ORDER

On June 20, 1961, the Commission issued Decision No. 62156 in the above-entitled investigation, declaring 42 of the respondents thereto to be radiotelephone utilities.

Subsequent to the issuance of Decision No. 62156, L. T. Niethammer and Valers M. Mitchell, doing business as Delta Mobile Radio Service and Carson E. Donaldson, doing business as

Mobilfone Lancaster, separately petitioned the Commission to amend said decision to include them among the respondents declared therein to be radiotelephone utilities.

Upon consideration of the information furnished with the petitions, the Commission finds that L. T. Niethammer and Valera M. Mitchell, doing business as Delta Mobile Radio Service, and Carson E. Donaldson, doing business as Mobilfone Lancaster, are radiotelephone utilities and that their names should be added to the respondents listed in Appendix A of Decision No. 62156; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A attached to and made a part of Decision No. 62156 be and it hereby is amended by adding the following thereto:

"L. T. Niethammer and Valera M. Mitchell,  
doing business as Delta Mobile Radio Service  
P. O. Box 578  
Rio Vista, California"

"Carson E. Donaldson, doing business as  
Mobilfone Lancaster  
123 West Nugent Street  
Lancaster, California"

2. The time limit for compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 2 and 3 of Decision No. 62156, only in so far as they pertain to the above-named respondents, be extended to October 30, 1961.

In all other respects Decision No. 62156 as heretofore amended shall remain in full force and effect.
