O R D E R

County of Sonoma is authorized to construct Guerneville Road at grade across a track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company near the City of Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 5-55.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The applicant advises that immediate authorization

is necessary to receive federal aid funds; therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
