ORDER Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across the east roadway of Alameda Street in the City of Huntington Park, Los Angeles County, at the Location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. EG-L88.11-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-E), reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material. Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time -1be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant advises that industry to be served requires rail service to its plant prior to completion of construction for purpose of receiving and transhipping commodities for which the plant is designed.
