O P I N I O N

By petition for Modification No. 217 in Case No. 5432, and  
by similar petitions in other minimum rate proceedings, Durkee  
Famous Foods (Division of The Glidden Company) seeks the amendment

of existing commodity descriptions in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and in other minimum rate tariffs as follows: Wherever a commodity description, whether relating to a commodity rate or to a classification exception rating, includes the entry "lard compounds" or the entry "shortening" it is proposed to amend said description by including the following entry:

"Monoglycerides, diglycerides or triglycerides of fat-forming fatty acids, or mixtures thereof, edible, other than shortening, with or without other edible acids."

Public hearing of the petitions was held before Examiner Carter R. Bishop at San Francisco on June 27, 1961.

A review of the minimum rate tariffs discloses that the sought modifications involve City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5. These tariffs provide minimum class and commodity rates which are applicable within the so-called East Bay Drayage Area, state wide, and within the Los Angeles Drayage Area, respectively.<sup>1</sup> The commodity descriptions here in issue apply in connection with certain classification exception ratings in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and in the East Bay Drayage tariff, and in connection with certain commodity rates contained in each of the three above-mentioned tariffs.

The record, as developed through testimony of petitioner's traffic manager, discloses the following facts: The glycerides here in issue are occasionally used individually as a shortening in bakery products, particularly in the manufacture of bread. Generally, however, they are combined with shortening. The addition

of the glycerides facilitates the emulsification of water and oil in the preparation of the bakery dough. Formerly the glycerides were described on bills of lading as "shortening" or "lard compounds", and when moving under class rates they were subject to the ratings provided therefor in Item No. 67840 of Western Classification No. 77 or in "exceptions" tariffs. Also, when transported under commodity rates the glycerides were subject to the rates on shortening or lard compounds.

Effective January 5, 1960 the aforesaid Western Classification was amended by the addition of Item No. 72465 in which were set forth ratings to apply specifically on the glycerides here in issue, under the same commodity description as that herein sought to be added to various items of the minimum rate tariffs.<sup>2</sup> Item No. 72465 became applicable on California intrastate traffic on May 15, 1961, under authority of Decision No. 61828.

The publication in the Western Classification of specific ratings on glycerides had the effect of making inapplicable to shipments of glycerides commodity rates published to apply on "shortening" or "lard compounds", until the commodity descriptions for such rates should be amended to include the glycerides.<sup>3</sup> The record shows that numerous rail commodity tariff descriptions have been amended, since the publication of Western Classification Item No. 72465, to include the same description on glycerides as set forth in that item. According to the witness, the modifications sought by the petitions herein are advanced in the interest of

tariff uniformity and to restore, for the transportation of glycerides, classification exception ratings and commodity rates on shortening and on lard compounds as set forth in the minimum rate tariffs.

According to the record, glycerides are similar to shortening in appearance, are similarly packaged and have the same transportation characteristics. Assertedly, the densities and values of the glycerides are almost identical with those of shortening. The experience with loss and damage claims is highly favorable.

Glycerides, as previously mentioned, are generally blended with shortening or lard at the point of production. The volume of movement of glycerides, as such, the record shows, is small. The shipments are in small individual lots or in mixed shipments with other products in truckload or carload lots.

Upon consideration of all the facts and circumstances of record we hereby find that commodity descriptions in the minimum rate tariffs which specify lard compounds or shortening should be amended to include the entry of monoglycerides and related articles as proposed by petitioner. The sought revisions have been justified. Petitions for Modification Nos. 217, 27 and 49 in Cases Nos. 5432, 5435 and 5441, respectively, will be granted.

The relief sought by petitioner does not affect minimum rate provisions which come within the scope of Case No. 5439 and no such provisions have as yet been established pursuant to Case No. 6322. Therefore, Petitions for Modification Nos. 13 and 1 in Cases Nos. 5439 and 6322, respectively, will be dismissed.

The order herein will provide for the amendment of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2. In order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 will be amended by separate orders.

O R D E R

Based upon the evidence of record and upon the findings and conclusions set forth in the preceding opinion,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix D of Decision No. No. 31606, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective October 28, 1961, the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:

Thirty-fourth Revised Page 5,  
Twenty-seventh Revised Page 7,  
Twenty-first Revised Page 9,  
Thirteenth Revised Page 38, and  
Fourteenth Revised Page 64.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be filed not earlier than the effective date hereof, and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than 120 days after the effective date of the tariff changes herein involved.

3. Common carriers are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Article XII, Section 21, of the State Constitution, and of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code, to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates or ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. Petitions for Modification No. 13 in Case No. 5439 and No. 1 in Case No. 6322 are hereby dismissed.

5. In all other respects said Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
