### SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 62559, entered today, the Commission revised certain commodity descriptions in City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5, by the addition thereto of certain monoglycerides and related articles. That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A should be amended by separate order.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 41362, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective October 28, 1961, the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:

- 2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be filed not earlier than the effective date hereof, and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than one hundred twenty days after the effective date of the tariff changes herein involved.
- 3. Common carriers are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Article XII, Section 21, of the State Constitution, and of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code, to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates or rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 4. In all other respects the aforesaid Decision No. 41362, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
