ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an extension to an existing track at grade in and along "O" Street in the City of Dinuba, Tulare County, at the location and substantially as described in the application.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry involved requires immediate service and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
