ORDER MODIFYING STAY

Decision No. 61282 having ordered respondent to desist public utility warehouse operations until it obtained a certificate therefor and filed tariffs; the operative effect of said decision having been stayed because of review proceedings by order of April 25, 1961; the Supreme Court having denied review (Private Warehouse v. Public Utilities Commission, S. F. No. 20712); such order of the Court having become final; respondent having been issued a certificate by Decision No. 61281, as amended, in Application No. 41521; the latter decision having been stayed by order of May 1, 1961 because of review proceedings; review thereof having been denied (Warehousemen's Assn. v. Public Utilities Commission, S. F. No. 20714); such order of the Supreme Court having become final; and the effective date of Decision No. 61281, as amended, by order issued concurrently herewith having been fixed as the date hereof;

IT IS ORDERED that the operative effect of Decision No. 61282 is further stayed until respondent F. J. BURNS WAREHOUSE

(corporate name changed by amendment of articles of incorporation filed with the Secretary of State on September 13, 1961) files its tariff with this Commission, or until 120 days from the date hereof, whichever event occurs earlier.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
