SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By the order in Decision No. 56524, dated April 15, 1958, the Commission authorized Diamond Bar Water Company, a corporation, to issue not to exceed \$1,800,000 of promissory notes on or before March 15, 1963, for the purpose of financing, in part, the construction of a water system.

The Commission's attention has been directed to the fact that the application contemplated that a portion of the note proceeds would be used for working capital, and that a modifying order would be appropriate to permit the expenditure of note proceeds for such intended purpose; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that -

1. Diamond Bar Water Company, a corporation, may expend not to exceed \$165,000 of the proceeds of the notes authorized by Decision No. 56524, dated April 15, 1958, for working capital as contemplated by Exhibit F attached to Application No. 39540.

2. Said Decision No. 56524 shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this supplemental order.

3. This supplemental order shall become effective on the date hereof.
