OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 62503, dated August 29, 1961, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity and tariffs of William C. White unless prior to the effective date of the decision he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to the order denying the facts set forth therein or shall have filed the proper and lawful tariffs and freight classification as required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code.

By petition, filed September 20, 1961, White seeks a postponement of the effective date of the order in said Decision No. 62503 until November 15, 1961, alleging that his tariffs and classification were canceled through oversight and inadvertence, and that the additional time is needed to effect their reinstatement.

The requested postponement of the order suspending the certificate would serve no purpose. No highway common carrier lawfully may engage or participate in the transportation of property unless and until its schedules of rates and classifications have been filed with the Commission, as required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code.
