In the Matter of the Application of MILES MOTOR TRANSPORT SYSTEM, a corporation, for modification of its certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 47105.

<u>O P I N I O N</u>

Miles Motor Transport System requests that its certificated authority be restricted against the transportation of fertilizers.

By Decision No. 47105, dated May 5, 1952, and Decision No. 60784, dated September 27, 1960, applicant was authorized to transport general commodities, with certain exceptions, between various points in California, including those within the San Francisco Territory, on the one hand, and the Los Angeles Territory, on the other hand. Under Decision No. 60784 applicant is restricted against the transportation of fertilizers, but is not so restricted under Decision No. 47105.

It is alleged that in the interest of uniformity it would be desirable to have the restrictions substantially similar throughout applicant's highway common carrier operations.

After consideration, the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's services for the transportation of fertilizers as described in Items Nos. 535, 540, and 550 of Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, Exception Sheet No. 1-S, M. A. Nelson, Tariff Publishing Officer, between the points authorized by Decision No. 47105. A public hearing is not necessary.

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O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The ordering paragraph (2) of Decision No. 47105 dated May 5, 1952, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following:

> "(h) Applicant shall not transport any shipments of fertilizers as described in Items Nos. 535, 540, and 550 of Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, Exception Sheet No. 1-S, M. A. Nelson, Tariff Publishing Officer."

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
