ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Decision No. 62504, dated August 29, 1961, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Walter G. Mitchell, Jr., unless, prior to the effective date of that decision, he shall have filed with this Commission a proper and lawful freight classification and tariffs as required by Sections 486 and 493 of the Public Utilities Code, in which event the order would be stayed.

On October 5, 1961, Western Classification Committee, Agent, filed Supplement 25-E to its Western Classification 77 reinstating Walter G. Mitchell, Jr., doing business as Auto Fast Freight, as a participant in said classification effective November 10, 1961. The required tariffs are also on file with the Commission. Inasmuch as the required classification and tariffs are now on file, Decision No. 62504, supra, will be vacated concurrently with the date upon which Mitchell's participation in said classification becomes effective.



The effective date of this order shall be November 10, 1961.


