O R D E R

The City of South San Francisco is authorized to construct San Mateo Avenue at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company in South San Francisco, San Mateo County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. E-9.73-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 46 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Construction activities on an approach to this crossing are now in progress and the applicant alleges that the contractor's

programming of work makes it desirable that the authorization requested be made effective immediately. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
