O R D E R

City of Coachella is authorized to construct 5th Street at grade across Southern Pacific Company's El Paso Route in the City of Coachella, Riverside County, at the location described in the application, as amended July 24, 1961, to be identified as Crossing No. B-614.6. Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement to be entered into between the City of Coachella and Southern Pacific Company, and an executed copy of said agreement shall be submitted to the Commission by applicant within 120 days of the effective date of this order. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Upon completion of Crossing No. B-614.6, the crossing at MP 614.4 located about 1000 feet northwesterly shall be abolished by physical closing by the City of Coachella.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
