SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 62802, entered today, the Commission found that a reduced exception rating of fourth-class on the transportation of plastic sheets should be established in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2 and 5, and in City Carriers' Tariff No. 2-A - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A. That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 should be amended by separate order.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) be, and it hereby is, further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective December 30, 1961, the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:

Eighth Revised Page 22

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be filed not earlier than the effective date hereof, and may be made effective on not less than

five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the tariff changes herein involved.

3. Common carriers be, and they hereby are, authorized to depart from the provisions of Article XII, Section 21, of the Constitution of the State of California, and of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code, to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; that such outstanding authorizations be and they are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and that schedules containing the rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
