SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 62329, dated July 25, 1961, the Commission, among other things, granted Sutton Investment Co., Lira Motors, Frederick A. Kilner and Florence A. Kilner, applicants, a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system in a portion of McKinney Shores Subdivision, Placer County. Ordering Paragraph 2 of said decision provided that the certificate would become effective upon correction of certain plant deficiencies.

By letter dated August 23, 1961, applicants advised the Commission that they had completed the construction necessary to correct said plant deficiencies. The Commission finds that by performing such construction applicants have complied with the conditions imposed by said Ordering Paragraph 2; therefore,


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to applicants by Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 62329 shall become effective on the effective date of this order.


2. In all other respects Decision No. 62329 shall remain in full force and effect.


The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.


