OPINION AND ORDER

Kleimer Van Lines, Inc., has filed with the Commission a written request asking for a 360-day suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted it in Decision No. 61997 and the following permits: Permit No. 19-38533 (Radial Highway Common Carrier), Permit No. 19-38534 (Highway Contract Carrier), Permit No. 19-41894 (City Carrier), and Permit No. 19-44954 (Household Goods Carrier).

The request and attached exhibit indicate that Kleimer has been operating at a substantial financial loss during 1961. Kleimer requests the suspension to enable it, if possible, to reorganize its operations.

The Commission finds that a public hearing in this matter is not necessary and that Kleimer should be authorized to suspend its operations for a period of 360 days.

IT IS ORDERED that Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 19-38533, Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 19-38534, City

Carrier Permit No. 19-41394, Household Goods Carrier Permit No. 19-44954, and the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Kleimer Van Lines, Inc., by Decision No. 61997 in Application No. 42442 are suspended for a period of 360 days.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Kleimer Van Lines, Inc., are hereby suspended for 360 days after the effective date hereof. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.
