ORDER ON PETITION FOR MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 60526, dated August 9, 1960, in Application No. 42473, the Commission authorized Dorris Telephone Company, a corporation, to issue \$17,000 of interim demand notes, and thereafter to issue its \$17,000 final note to replace the interim notes. Subsequently, by Decision No. 61577, dated February 28, 1961, in Application No. 43126, the Commission authorized the company to issue \$5,000 of interim demand notes, and thereafter to combine the \$5,000 with said \$17,000 indebtedness, and to issue its \$22,000 final note to replace the interim notes.

The company reports that through inadvertence neither of the earlier applications contained a request to execute a new loan agreement and mortgage. In a petition for modification filed on November 8, 1961, the company seeks to correct the omission and it has filed copies of the two instruments and has requested the necessary authorization to execute them.

The Commission has considered this petition for modification and finds and concludes that a public hearing is not necessary, and that the petition should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that -

1. Dorris Telephone Company, a corporation, may enter into a loan agreement with General Dynamics Corporation, and may execute and deliver a mortgage, which agreement and mortgage shall be in the same form, or substantially in the same form, as those attached to its petition for modification as Exhibit A and Exhibit B, respectively.

2. Dorris Telephone Company, a corporation, may execute and deliver any supplemental mortgages required by the terms of said loan agreement.

3. The Orders in Decisions Nos. 60526, dated August 9, 1960, and 61577, dated February 28, 1961, shall remain in full force and effect, except that the time within which Dorris Telephone Company, a corporation, may issue the notes under the authority granted hereby is extended to and including March 31, 1962.
