SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 62752 of October 31, 1961 in this proceeding, Special Service Transportation Corporation, Ltd., was authorized to transport groceries and related articles between designated points for Certified Grocers of California, at rates which are less than the established minimum rates. Said decision provided that the rates authorized therein should be made subject to the same increases as might be made, pursuant to Petition for Modification No. 233 in Case No. 5432, in the corresponding rates named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2. Decision No. 62752 further stated that a supplemental order in the instant proceeding would be issued giving effect to such increases, if any.

By Decision No. 62782 of November 7, 1961, in the aforesaid Petition for Modification No. 233 in Case No. 5432, various increases were made in the rates and charges set forth in the aforesaid Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2. The effective date of those increases is December 16, 1961.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix "A" of Decision No. 62752, in Application No. 43544, is hereby amended, effective December 16, 1961, by substituting for Items 4 and 5 thereof, Items 4-A and 5-A, respectively, as set forth in the "Appendix" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects said Decision No. 62752 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be December 16, 1961.
