Application of County of Kern, a political subdivision of the State of California, for order authorizing construction of a crossing at grade over the Southern Pacific Railroad, approximately one mile south of Crossing No. B-381.5.

## <u>order</u>

County of Kern is authorized to construct Holt Road at grade across Southern Pacific Company's El Paso Route near the Community of Mojave, Kern County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-382.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 44 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall by by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant has asked that authority be made effective as early as possible so that access and service to several new industries may be expedited; therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
