OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 61279, dated December 28, 1960, in Application No. 42817, San Francisco Warehouse Co. was authorized to unload and segregate pool car shipments of periodicals for The Cuneo Press within San Francisco without assessing the charges set forth in City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A for marking, stenciling, tagging or labeling. The current authority is scheduled to expire January 5, 1962. By this application permission is sought to continue the above authority.

The application states that applicant handles a railroad car of periodicals for The Cuneo Press once a month. Prior to the granting of the relief herein involved, the bundles were marked by the shipper. The present application states that the cost to applicant of performing the services of unloading and segregating is less now that applicant marks or stencils the bundles of periodicals than it would be if the shipper marked or stenciled them; that the savings realized by applicant in the course of unloading and segregating far outweigh the small cost to applicant of marking or stenciling; and that the relief sought will result in operating economies to applicant without loss of revenue.

The application shows that, on or about October 25, 1961, a copy thereof was served upon the Draymen's Association of San Francisco, Inc. No objection to its being granted has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that applicant's proposal is reasonable and consistent with the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted. Because the conditions under which the transportation is performed may change at any time the authority which follows will be made to expire at the end of one year.

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) San Francisco Warehouse Co., a corporation, is hereby exempted from assessing the charges prescribed in paragraph (d) of Item No. 220 of City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A for performing the services designated as marking, tagging, stenciling, or labeling in connection with pool car shipments of periodicals for The Cuneo Press.


(2) The authority herein granted shall, on and after January 6, 1962, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 61279 and shall expire with January 5, 1963.


This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.


