

Applicant has been providing a passenger stage service in Watsonville and territory adjacent thereto, pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 50543, dated September 14, 1954, in Application No. 35745, as amended by Decision No. 54004, dated October 30, 1956, in Application No. 38384. Applicant now seeks an order authorizing discontinuance of said service upon the grounds that his insurance has been canceled effective October 15, 1961, and he is unable to effect renewal thereof for any amount less than \$1,350 per month, which amount exceeds anticipated gross revenues. Prior to October 15, 1961, applicant had coverage under a temporary arrangement in conjunction with another bus company whereby applicant's insurance cost \$350 per month.

Under the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds that applicant's service cannot be provided on a compensatory basis. Accordingly, applicant will be permitted to discontinue service and the ensuing order will so provide.

1. That Charles F. Hushbeck is authorized to abandon his passenger stage service in and around Watsonville, California.

2. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 50543 dated September 14, 1954, in Application No. 35745 as amended by Decision No. 54004 dated October 30, 1956, in Application No. 38384, is canceled and revoked.

3. That any and all tariffs, timetables, powers of attorney and concurrences filed by or on behalf of Charles F. Hushbeck are hereby canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
