ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Manuel Castanon has been suspended since August 28, 1960, for failure to file tariffs as required under the Public Utilities Code.¹ The carrier has not filed the required tariffs since that date.

Manuel Castanon having failed to maintain the required tariffs in effect and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for the revocation of the certificate and cancellation of the related power of attorney,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Manuel Castanon by Decision No. 52894 dated April 17, 1956, in Application No. 36510, is hereby revoked.


(2) Power of Attorney AFL No. 1 issued by Manuel Castanon in favor of Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., is hereby canceled.


¹The certificate authorizes service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of fresh fruits and vegetables between points in Coachella Valley Territory and Los Angeles.


The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Manuel Castanon or after the above mailing to Manuel Castanon, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, or requesting public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
