ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR MODIFICATION

It appearing that the Commission in Decision No. 59006 ordered petitioners to examine their records for the period September 1, 1957 to September 15, 1959 to ascertain if undercharges, other than those set forth in said decision, occurred, and

It appearing that petitioners' examination disclosed undercharges of \$4,547.90 in connection with shipments transported by them for General Foods Corporation, and

It appearing that petitioners, by petition filed July 6, 1961, requested authority to accept the sum of \$2,000.00 in full settlement of the said sum of \$4,547.90, and

It appearing that the Commission in Decision No. 62569 dated September 12, 1961 authorized petitioners to waive collection of said undercharges amounting to \$4,547.90, and

It appearing that petitioners, by petition filed October 11, 1961, request the Commission to modify Decision No. 62569 so as to authorize them to accept and retain the sum of \$2,000.00 in full settlement and satisfaction of the said sum of \$4,547.90 and to waive the remaining balance of \$2,547.90, and

The Commission having considered each and every allegation of such petition and finding no good cause for granting the same,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for modification filed herein, October 11, 1961, is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
