## Decision No. <u>62328</u>

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SAN JOSE CITY LINES, INC. for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity under Section 1031 of the Public Utilities Code to operate a passenger stage service over and upon certain Public Highways within the City of Santa Clara and adjacent thereto.

#### SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

The Commission by Decision No. 61168 dated December 13, 1960, in the above numbered application granted to San Jose City Lines, Inc. a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide passenger stage service within and around the City of Santa Clara in accordance with an agreement between the city and applicant for a period of six months.

By Decision No. 62138 dated July 13, 1961, the Commission authorized a reduction in this service upon request of the City of Santa Clara in order to afford the city an opportunity to make further studies of the future need for this service.

By letter of November 29, 1961, San Jose City Lines, Inc. advised that the City of Santa Clara had passed a motion at a meeting held November 21, 1961, requesting the discontinuance and termination of this service be made effective after December 23, 1961, and that the city desires to discontinue subsidizing the two routes involved (Nos. 8-A and 8-B). A certified copy of the pertinent portion of City Council Minutes was attached to the letter from the City Lines.

After consideration, the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the requested discontinuance of these two routes. A public hearing is not necessary.

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Request having been made and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(2) That within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than one-day notice, applicant may discontinue the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, amendments to its tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.
